IN THE NAME OF AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

The Grand Jurors of the State of Florida and County of Duval, empaneled and sworn to inquire and true presentment make in and for the body of the County of Duval, upon their oaths, do present and charge that:

COUNT 1

QUINTAE HUDSON, on March 27, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did unlawfully and from a premeditated design to effect the death of Michael Wright, did then and there, as a principal, kill the said Michael Wright, a human being, by shooting him, contrary to the provisions of Sections 782.04(1)(a) and 777.011 Florida Statutes.

COUNT 2

QUINTAE HUDSON on or between February 12, 2016 and March 27, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did agree, conspire, combine or confederate with Hercules Bowers, Shersonya Bowers, Ashley Williams, Thomisha Morgan, or another person, to unlawfully and from a premeditated design, effect the death of Michael Wright, a human being, and the said QUINTAE HUDSON committed the aforementioned Conspiracy to Commit Murder in the First Degree for the purpose of benefiting, promoting, or furthering the interests of a criminal gang, contrary to the provisions of Sections 782.04(1)(a), 874.04 and 777.04(3), Florida Statutes.

COUNT 3

QUINTAE HUDSON on or between February 12, 2016 and March 27, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did knowingly use intimidation or physical force, or threatened another person, or attempted to do so, or engaged in misleading conduct towards another person, or offered pecuniary benefit or gain to another person, with intent to cause or induce Michael Wright to withhold testimony from an official proceeding or to be absent from an official proceeding to which Michael Wright had been summoned by legal process, where the official proceeding affected involved the prosecution of a second degree felony, and the said QUINTAE HUDSON committed the aforementioned Tampering with a Witness for the purpose of benefiting, promoting, or furthering the interests of a criminal gang, contrary to the provisions of Sections 914.22(1), 914.22(2)(c) and 874.04, Florida Statutes.

COUNT 4

QUINTAE HUDSON on or between February 12, 2016 and November 18, 2016 in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did knowingly use intimidation or physical force, or threatened another person, or attempted to do so, or engaged in misleading conduct towards another person, or offered pecuniary benefit or gain to another person, with intent to cause or induce Rashiid Anderson to withhold testimony from an official proceeding, to evade legal process summoning that person to appear as a witness in an official proceeding, to produce a record, document or other object in an official proceeding, or to be absent from an official proceeding to which Rashiid Anderson had been summoned by legal process, or testify untruthfully in an official proceeding, where the official proceeding affected involved the prosecution of a second degree felony, and the said QUINTAE HUDSON committed the aforementioned Tampering with a Witness for the purpose of benefiting, promoting, or furthering the interests of a criminal gang, contrary to the provisions of Sections 914.22(1), 914.22(2)(c), and 874.04 Florida Statutes.

COUNT 5

QUINTAE DAVOURIS HUDSON on or between February 12, 2016 and November 18, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did knowingly use intimidation or physical force, or threatened another person, or attempted to do so, or engaged in misleading conduct towards another person, or offered pecuniary benefit or gain to another person, with intent to cause or induce Nateketa Lloyd to withhold testimony from an official proceeding, to evade legal process summoning that person to appear as a witness in an official proceeding, or to be absent from an official proceeding to which Nateketa Lloyd had been summoned by legal process, or to testify untruthfully in an official proceeding, where the official proceeding affected involved the prosecution of a second degree felony, and the said QUINTAE HUDSON committed the aforementioned Tampering with a Witness for the purpose of benefiting, promoting, or furthering the interests of a criminal gang, contrary to the provisions of Sections 914.22(1), 914.22(2)(c) and 874.04 Florida Statutes.

COUNT 6


QUINTAE DAVOURIS HUDSON on or between May 27, 2016 and December 13, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did knowingly use intimidation or physical force, or threatened another person, or attempted to do so, or engaged in misleading conduct towards another person, or offered pecuniary benefit or gain to another person, with intent to cause or induce Ashley Williams to withhold testimony from an official proceeding, to evade legal process summoning that person to appear as a witness in an official proceeding, or to be absent from an official proceeding to which Ashley Williams had been summoned by legal process, where the official proceeding affected involved the prosecution of a second degree felony, and the said QUINTAE HUDSON committed the aforementioned Tampering with a Witness for the purpose of benefiting, promoting, or furthering the interests of a criminal gang, contrary to the provisions of Sections 914.22(1), 914.22(2)(c) and 874.04 Florida Statutes.

COUNT 7

QUINTAE DAVOURIS HUDSON on or between February 12, 2016 and December 13, 2016, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did knowingly initiate, organize, plan, finance, direct, manage, or supervise criminal gang activity contrary to the provisions of Section 874.10, Florida Statutes.

COUNT 8

QUINTAE DAVOURIS HUDSON on or between October 18, 2014 and October 19, 2014, in the County of Duval and the State of Florida, did wantonly or maliciously throw any missile or hurl or project a stone or other hard substance which would produce death or great bodily harm at, within or into a vehicle, which is being used or occupied by any person, contrary to the provisions of Section 790.19, Florida Statutes.






