ORDER

The Court examined Defendant, **Katrina Brown**, under oath and found her without sufficient resources within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3006A to employ counsel, and **Darcy D. Galnor, Esquire** is hereby appointed to represent Defendant. It appears that funds are available for reimbursement in part for the services rendered to Defendant by appointed counsel. Accordingly, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 3006A(f), **no later than July 30, 2018**, Defendant shall deposit \$1,000.00 to the Clerk of Court for deposit into the current CJA appropriations account. Said deposit shall be set aside for reimbursement of attorney's fees and costs expended on Defendant's behalf. Thereafter, Defendant shall make **monthly** deposits into the registry of the Clerk of Court in the amount of **\$100 per month** for the pendency of the case. These deposits are due **on or before the last business day of each month**, with the first \$100 deposit being due no later than **August 31, 2018**.
